KNOW IT



The Christian life is a continual journey of becoming more like Jesus. As we grow, we align our lives with God's heart and purposes.

- **What does alignment with God mean to you? What are you currently aiming your life toward, and how has that "bullseye" shifted over time?**

Read: Colossians 3:23, 1 Corinthians 10:31, Psalm 37:5, Proverbs 16:3.

Following Jesus is personal, but it was never meant to be lived alone. When the church is aligned around Jesus and His purposes, something begins to overflow into the way we live.

- **When a church is truly aligned together around Jesus, what do you think naturally overflows from that community?**

Read: Acts 2:42–47, Philippians 2:1–11, Colossians 2:1–10

Read: Colossians 3:1–4, Matthew 6:33, 9:36, 22:37–40

When God brings alignment to our vision, it naturally overflows into mission. We fix our eyes on things above while putting our hands and feet to work for the people around us.

- **Why is it important to seek God first before deciding what to pursue? How does consulting Him keep our vision aligned with His?**
