Pastor Jon gave us a powerful reminder this weekend that "God's Kindness is True and Faithful in Every Generation and Every Situation." Sometimes, when we are in the midst of a storm, like Naomi, it is hard to remember this truth. Is there anything in your life right now making it hard for you to remember this truth about God's kindness?

When we are walking through a hard time, caused by us or by someone else, it can be hard to remember or believe that God is still working on our behalf. In fact, the enemy will even use these times to make us doubt, question and turn toward anything but God. This week let's look at some promises God makes in His Word for us. Read each verse and write down what God is promising.

Read through those verses one right after the other, and let their power permeate your heart. Oftentimes, when our lives are hard, we simply need to read God's promises over and over to remember that His "kindness is true and faithful in every generation and every situation." Our circumstances may not change immediately, but our hearts and minds focused on Him will give us the strength to take the next step. To end the week, read 2 Corinthians 10:5 and Romans 12:2 and ask God to help you focus on Him and His promises.
